



## Transfer and registration rules from the LLM Old Regulations to the LLM Revised Regulations

The following will apply automatically to *students who are currently registered for the LLM and to students whose first period of registration has ceased or has been terminated within three years of their application to register for the revised programme*. All other students who were registered previously for the LLM, and who wish to register for the revised programme, will be considered on an individual basis and at the discretion of the University (i.e. at the discretion of the Director of the Postgraduate Laws programme in accordance with the wishes of the Lead Colleges).
